## CINCINNATI CATHOLIC CEMETERY SOCIETY FLOWER RULES & REGULATIONS FOR CEMETERY

- IMPORTANT NOTICE: Any and All tributes, decorations, and flowers

  NOT in a permanent vase on the lot or grave will be removed weekly

  on every Wednesday throughout the mowing season of March 1<sup>st</sup>

  through October 31<sup>st</sup> except where specifically noted by management.
- 1. From March 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>, all decorations not in permanent vases will be gathered and discarded one (1) week after special holidays/Holydays.
- 2. Containers made of glass and other easily broken material, shall be prohibited and if placed will be collected and discarded immediately.
- 3. Power mowers hitting objects of glass, wire, etc. will propel sharp pieces of the object through the air for 100 feet or more, endangering the lives of workmen and visitors alike. Please refrain from using pieces of wire to hold flowers in place.
- 4. When artificial flowers, wreaths, etc. are placed on graves, we suggest you remove them before we start mowing your particular section. The cemetery is not responsible for them.
- 5. Artificial flowers and wreaths in good condition will be permitted to remain from November 1<sup>st</sup> till February 28<sup>th</sup>.

## Memorial Vigil Lights:

- 1. Vigil Lights are permitted on the graves in the cemetery from November 1<sup>st</sup> to February 28<sup>th</sup>, which is the non-mowing season.
- 2. The lights may be placed on the graves for the following holidays Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day and Father's Day, during the grass growing season. The lights may be placed for one (1) week before the holiday and must be promptly removed one (1) week after the holiday.
- 3. It is the family's total responsibility to place and remove these lights. The cemetery is not responsible if they are broken or stolen.
- 4. If the Vigil Lights are not promptly removed by the family by the specified time, they will be collected and discarded by cemetery management.

## FLOWER PLACEMENT PROGRAM:

The CCCS has an order form with all the information for our flower placement program. It is to be used for holidays/Holydays and any other special occasions (i.e. birthdays, anniversaries or any special date, etc.) These placements will remain for one (1) week.

## Trash:

Trash containers are placed throughout the cemetery for your convenience. When you are visiting it would be a tremendous help, especially on the holidays when we are unable to keep them from overflowing, to please take your boxes, paper, etc. with you. Your co-operation will be greatly appreciated.
